Open Data



in Belgium

- *The PSI directive resulted in an agreement (24 July 2015) in the Belgian Federal council of ministers to*
 - *Adopt a federal open data strategy with an ambitious roadmap for 2015-2020*
 - *Propose a project of law (that was already agreed upon in the council of ministers) to transpose the directive*
 - *Create a task force, consisting of BOSA DG Digital Transformation and the Service for Administrative Simplification*

Federal Open Data Strategy :

- The norm is “open by default”
- All federal government data is eligible to be published as open data
- Exceptions are (only) possible for reasons of privacy or (national) security
- Goal is to have free reuse without having to mention the source (facilitates combining datasets)
- Data are as much as possible offered in reusable and open formats
- Before 2020, the federal government opens data proactively and not only on request
- Priority is on much requested data
- One unique federal open data portal : <https://data.gov.be>
- Maximal continuity : data has to remain available
- Each federal public service has to develop a open data strategy and appoints a champion

Over 7000 datasets are available.
The site provides a search function and navigation by theme.



Why ?

- Open Data has an enormous economic potential
- Agoria, the sector federation of IT in Belgium, estimates that a net gain of 900 million € can be achieved by opening up government data
- Benefits
 - Improvement of data quality
 - Strengthening legitimacy
 - Stimulate openness and user centricity
 - Higher interoperability
 - Transparency, promoting citizen participation in democracy
 - Tap on third parties creativity

National strategy for eGovernment



in Belgium

- Belgium ranks 6th in the Digital Economy and Society Index (DESI) 2017.
- Belgium ranks highest in connectivity (3rd) and integration of digital technology by businesses (5th), while digital public services are its biggest relative weakness.
- The country's key challenge is to continuously improve its mobile connectivity.
- *Our goals for 2020 (Minister of Digital Agenda) :*
 - *Become 3rd in the DESI index*
 - *75% of interactions available digitally*
 - *75% of digitally available interactions effectively used*

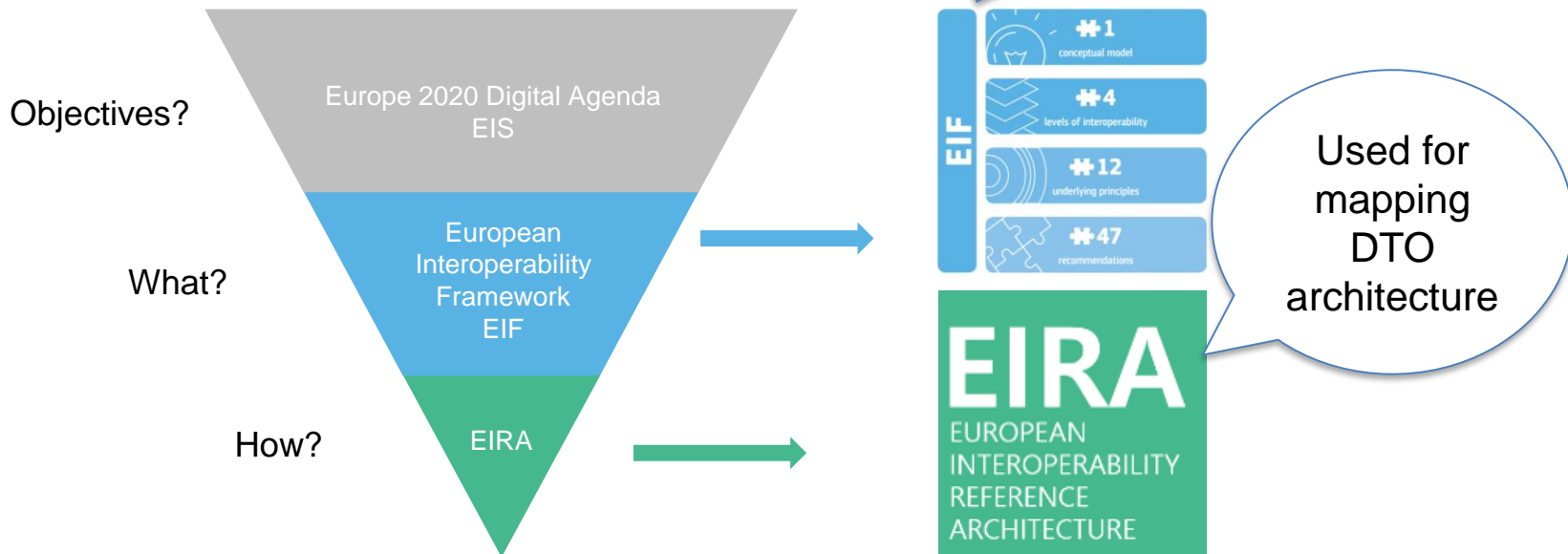

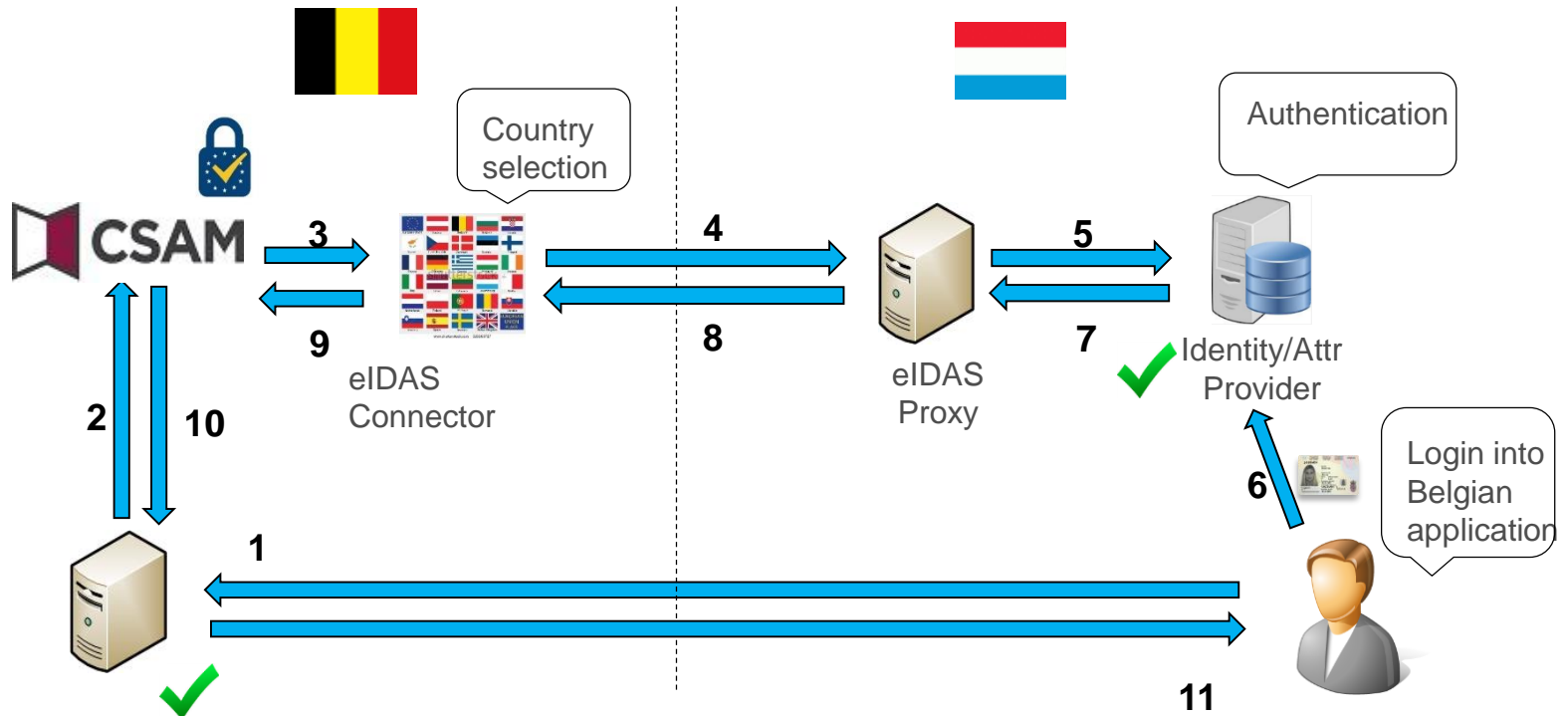

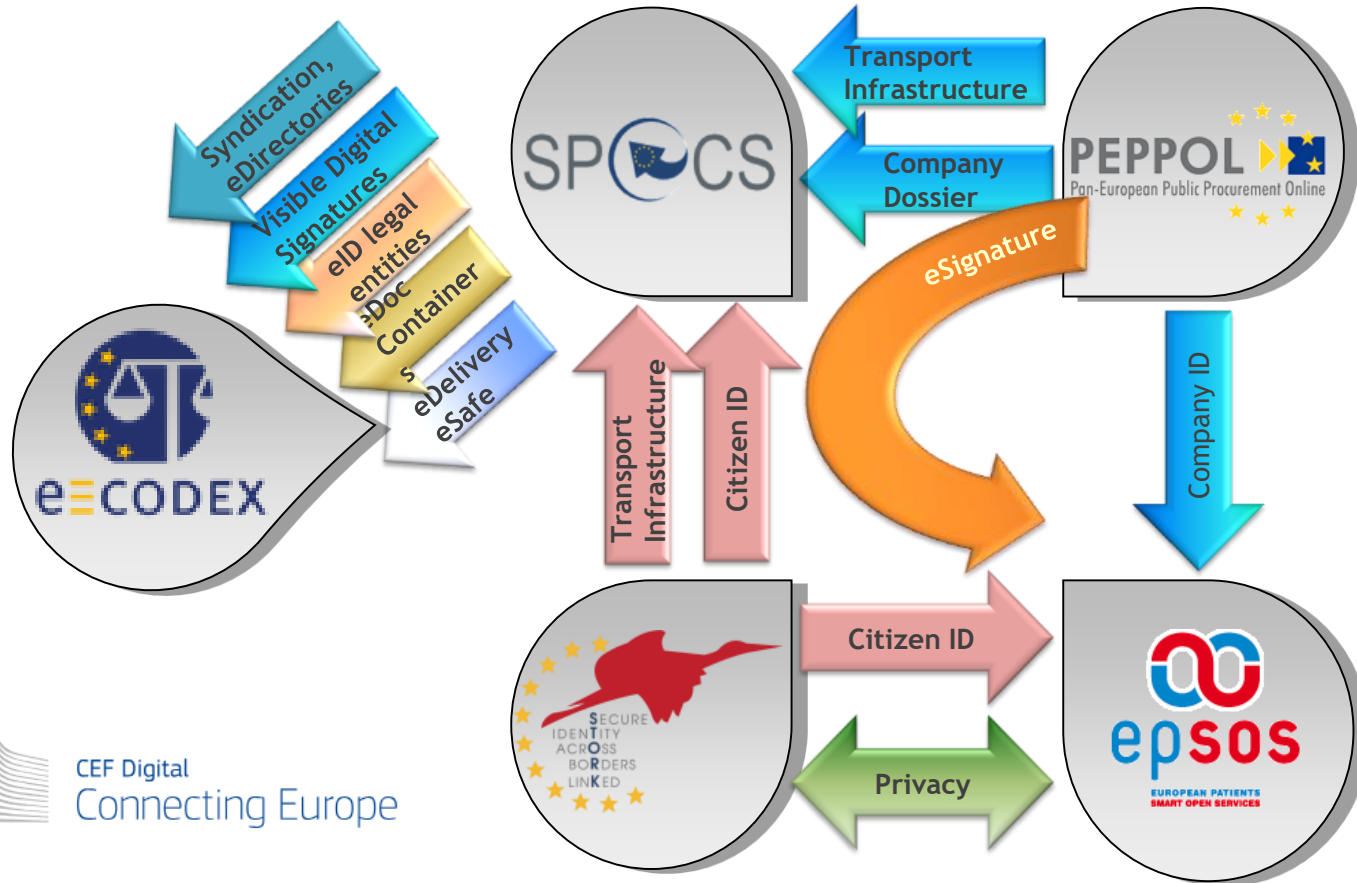

Belgium participated in many EU large scale pilots

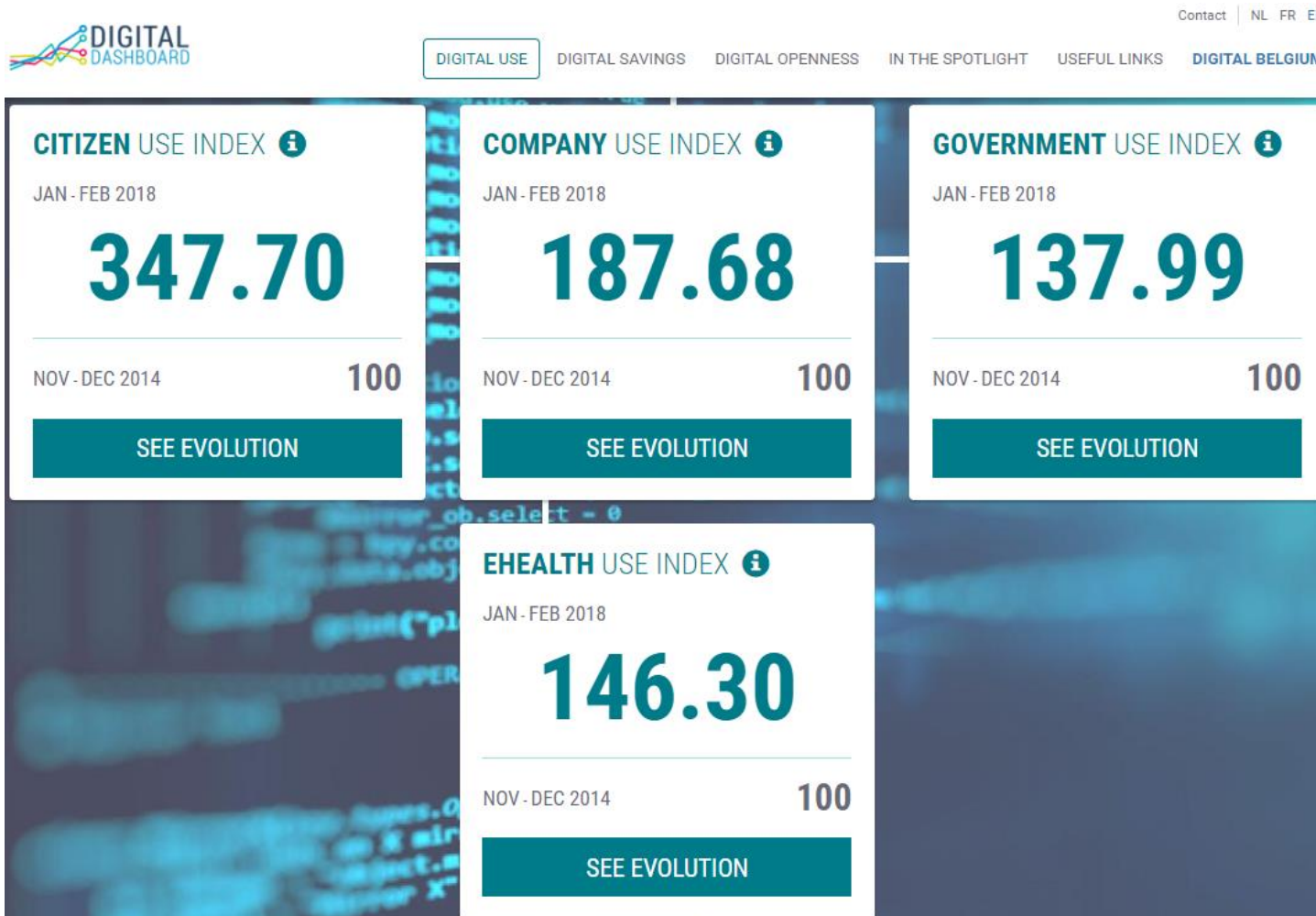

- In parallel : “Informatie Vlaanderen” is also very active





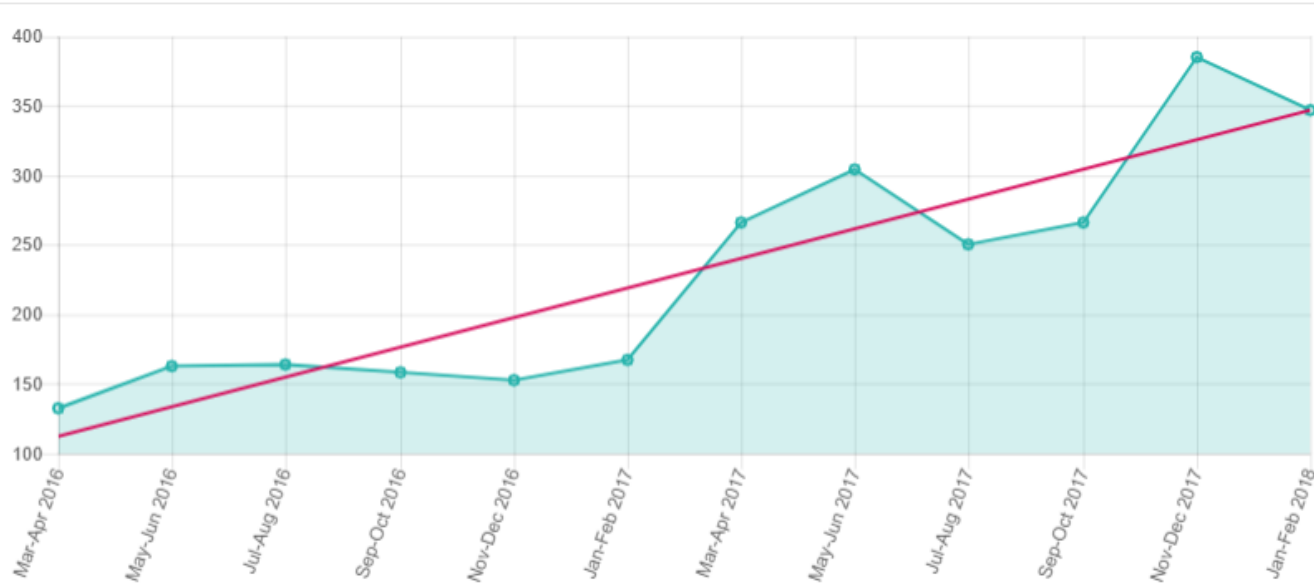

- *Multilingualism is important in Belgium*
 - *At Federal level, NL/FR is an obligation*
 - *In Flanders, it **MUST** be in NL*
 - *In Brussels, NL/FR is an obligation*
 - *In Wallonia, FR is an obligation, but in the eastern part FR/GE is an obligation*
- All federal public digital services are at least bi-lingual
- With Brussels being the capital of Europe, EN is also very important

Multilingualism to enable cross-border public services

A Single Digital Gateway:

In the future, people and companies will have easier access, through a single digital entry point, to high quality information, online administrative procedures and assistance services.

Any procedure currently available online for domestic users will be accessible to users from other Member States and in one additional EU language.

13 key administrative procedures will have to be made available online, including requests for a birth certificate, to register a car, start a business or register for social security benefits.

- › Archief: Babelfed laat je toe om vroegere vertalingen te consulteren
