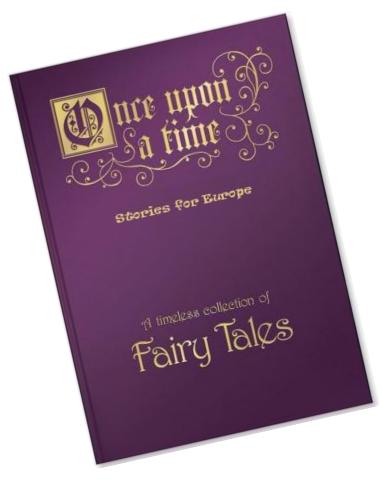

Where the story began



- ☐ Implementation of EU legislation depends on partnership and administrative cooperation
- □ Administrative cooperation needs support especially in an EU of 28 Member States
- □ Local regional and national competent authorities need to exchange information
- □ Legal requirement of the Services Directive (2005)



Where the story began

- BUT...
 - □ Different languages barrier for communication
 - □ Different administrative cultures
 - **□** Lack of clearly identified partners
 - □ Lack of agreed procedures
 - □ 378 bilateral relationships to manage
 - □ Off-line information exchange takes long
 - Proliferation of IT solutions should be avoided



IMI – Administrative cooperation service

- **□** Generic online application
- Multilingual system available in all EU languages
- Well defined structured procedures
- □ Database of competent authorities
- □ Legal certainty clear legal basis
- □ Pre-defined and translated communications: questions, answers, messages and forms



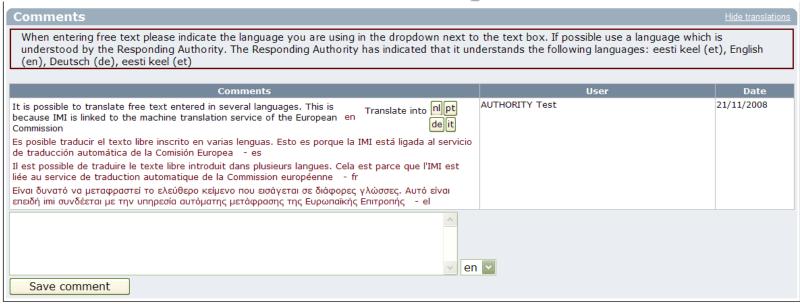
Need for additional language support

- □ Communications cannot be fully pre-defined
- □ Clear need for supplementary free-text communication
- ☐ Supporting documents are exchanged in original language

- Machine translation for free text and documents
- > Ensuring privacy of content



ECMT – The early solution



- ☐ IMI pioneering the integration in 2009/10
- □ Available only for certain combination of languages
- □ Evolution and further development of the service was not guaranteed
- □ Service withdrawn



Use of MT@EC as soon as possible

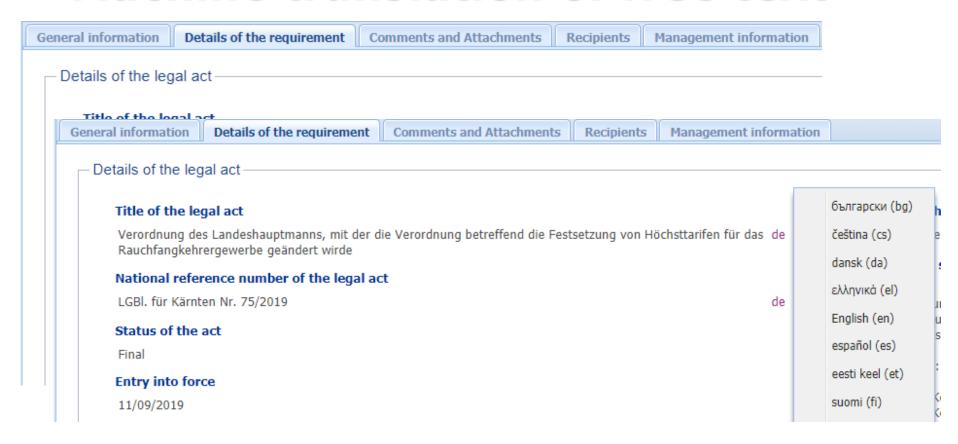
- □ Strong user demand to reintroduce machine translation
- □ Pilot use of first available version of MT@EC
- ☐ Limited language pairs:

from all EU languages to English and from English to all EU languages

- □ Adapted technical implementation in IMI
 - Introduce storage of translation requests
 - Handling 20+ target languages



Machine translation of free text



- □ Possibility to request translations for free text fields
- ☐ Selection of language after clicking the icon



Machine translation of free text



- □ Translations stored for the user
- □ When available possible to retrieve from dedicated menu option

Machine translation of free text

- □ Out of context display
- Not easy to retrieve translations
- ☐ Cumbersome to translate multiple free text fields
- □ Repeated submission of translation requests by multiple users
- □ At early stage response time was found too long by users
- □ Increased usage as new language pairs became available



ISSUES

Improved handling of machine translated text



- □ Translate all free text to session language
- **☐** Single click

Improved handling of machine translated text

□ Storage and speedy retrieval of previously translated free text from the IMI database

☐ Significant reduction of response time



This is not yet the end of the story

- □ Machine translation service improved
- □ Improved quality triggered more frequent use
- □ Continous upgrade and evolution of eTranslation
- ☐ IMI expanded to support more areas and more communications
- New requirements were raised by the users

Already released / worked on

- Extended period for storage of translations in IMI
- > Address incorrectly indicated source language



This is not yet the end of the story

Planned inprovements

- ➤ Include machine translation of free text within printouts of exchanges
- > Provide machine translation for attached documents
- Automatic language recognition

- □ eTranslation already offers more
- Integration of additional features is envisaged for the benefit of IMI users

... increasing demand for the integrated machine translation service

- □ IMI already supports 17 policy areas and 50+ administrative cooperation procedures
- □ New procedures involve multiple authorities not only bilateral, but also one-to-many exchanges
- □ 11500+ competent authorities are registered in the system
- □ 33000 registered users across the EEA area
- □ Almost 37000 communications in 2018
