

DIGITAL TEXT AS CAPITAL/BENEFITS OF SHARING LANGUAGE DATA

- "More data is better data"
 - Granted it is good quality data
- Sharing LR will improve eTranslation which we all can profit from (directly as a public servant or indirectly as a citizen by e.g. using public digital services)
- ELRC can process your translations and create ready to use TMs





DIGITAL TEXT AS CAPITAL/BENEFITS OF SHARING LANGUAGE DATA
