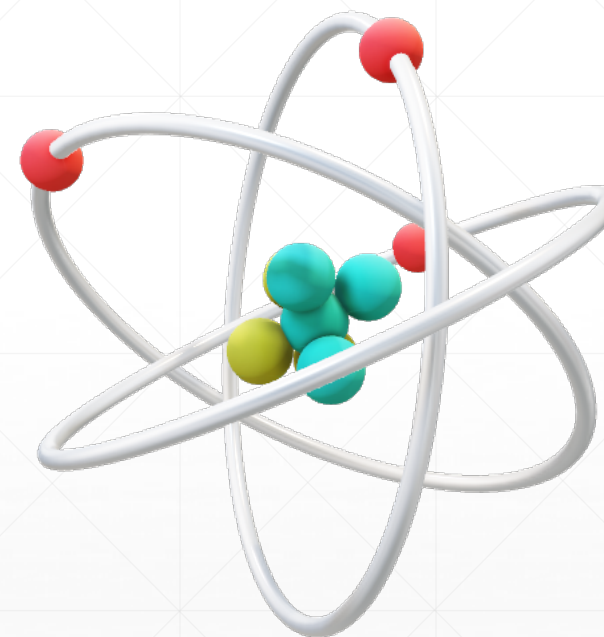

Objectives

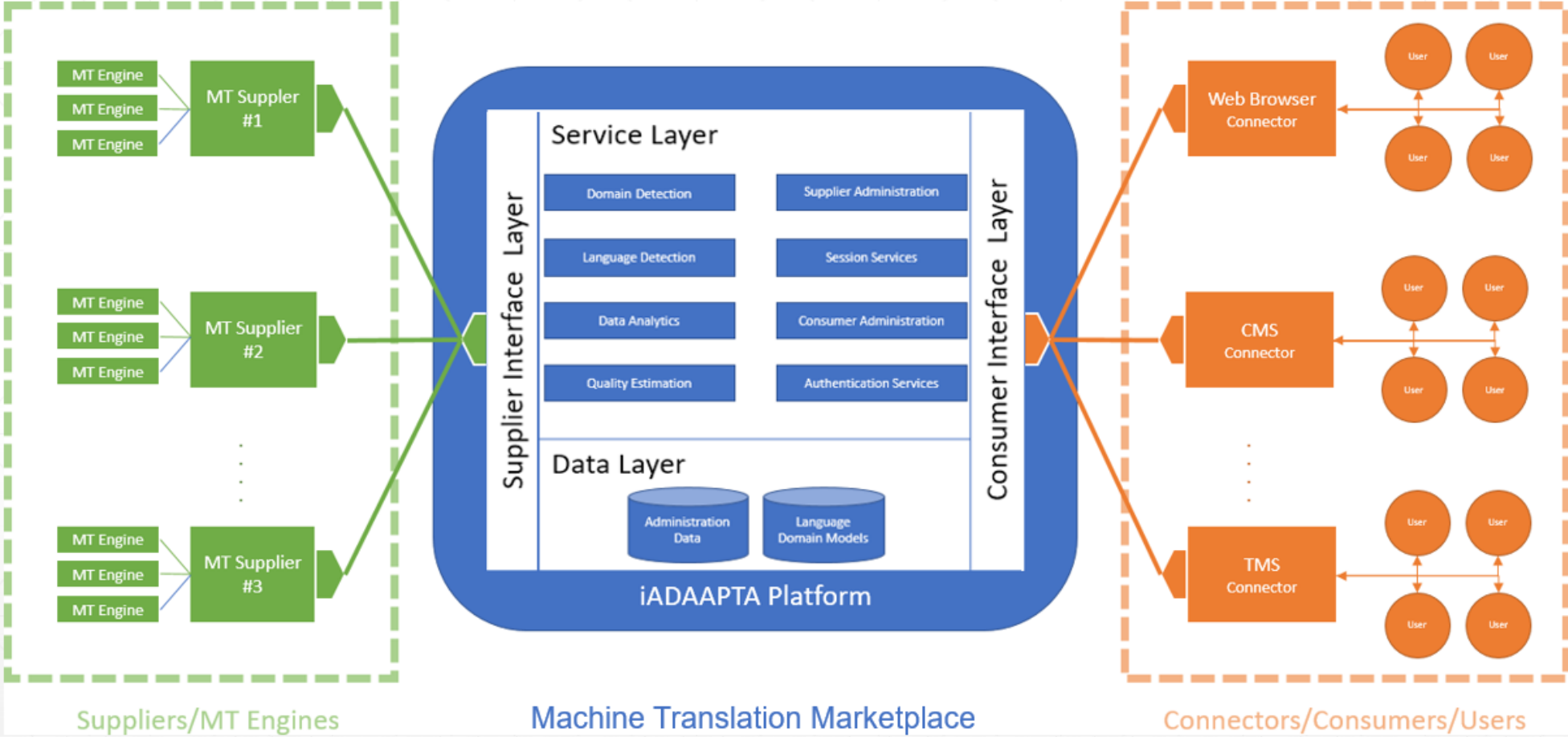
- **The iADAATPA Platform will deliver on the following objectives**

 - 40+ generic and domain adapted machine translation engines

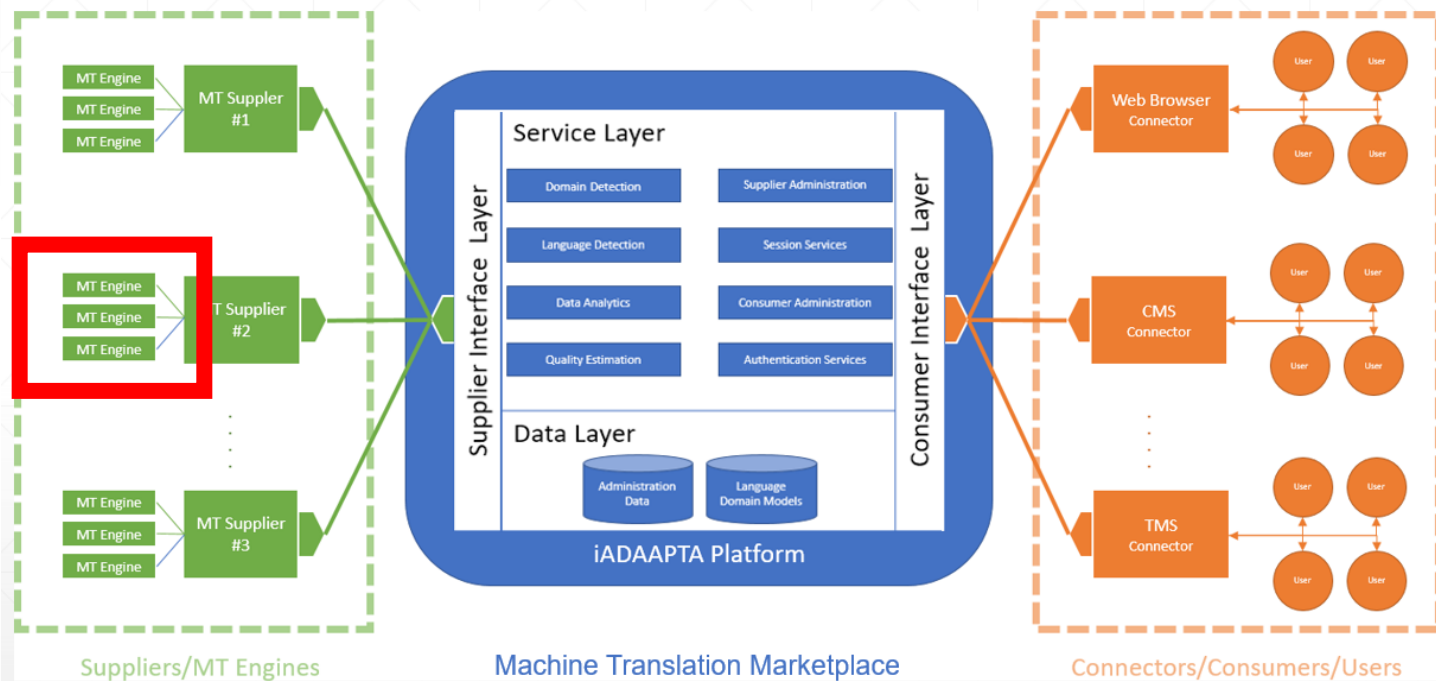
