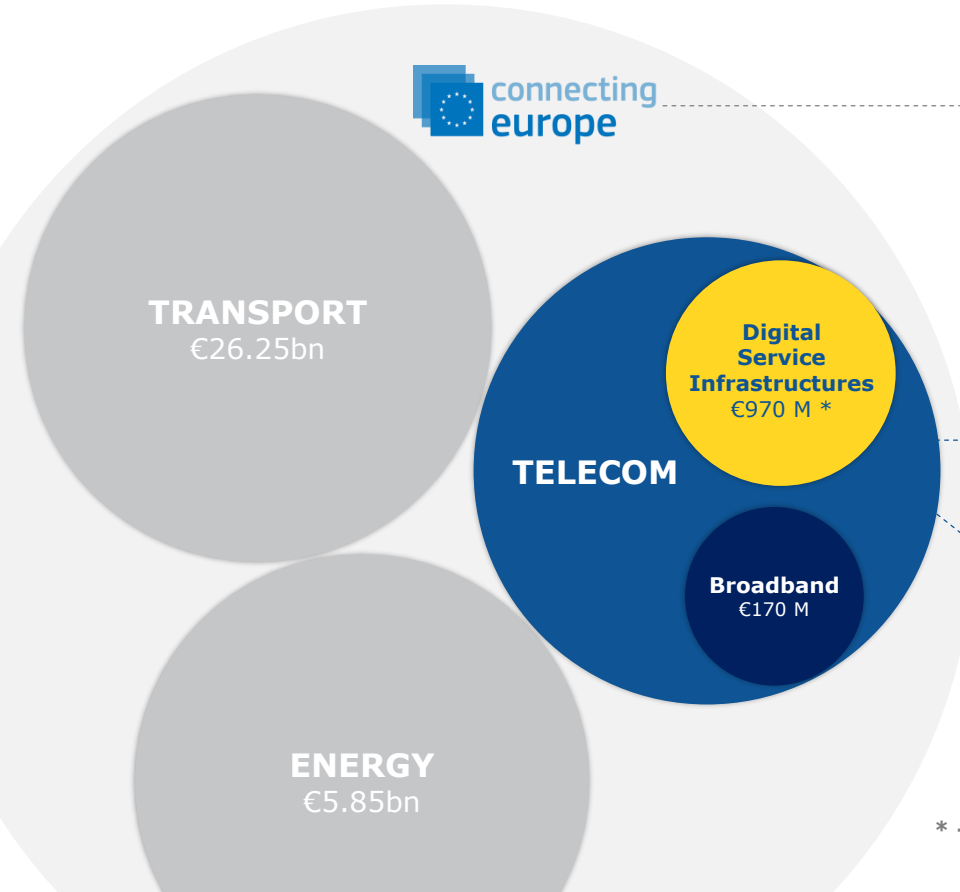

CEF Regulation

The Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) is a regulation that defines how the Commission can finance support for the establishment of trans-European networks to reinforce an interconnected Europe.

CEF Telecom Guidelines

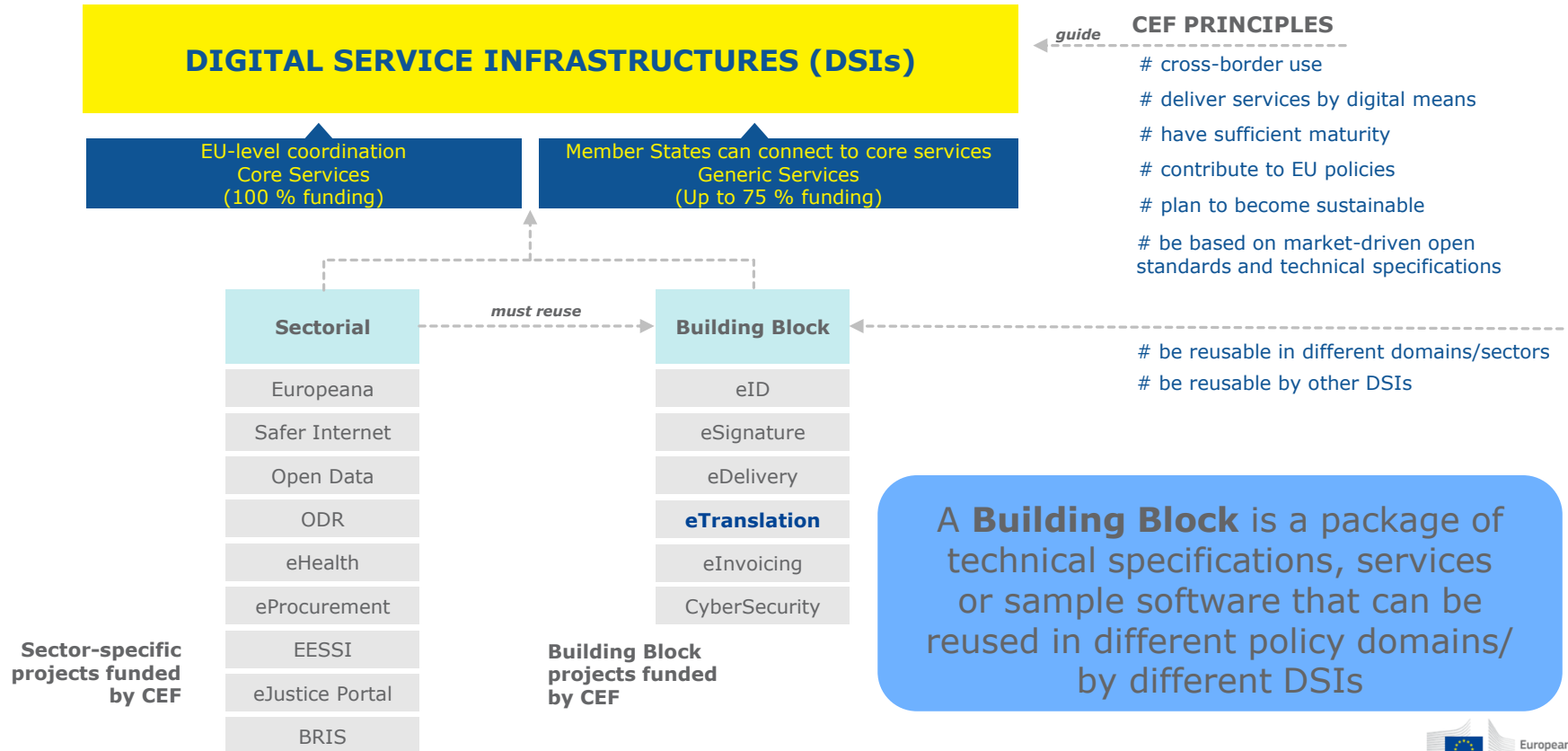
The CEF Telecom guidelines cover the specific objectives and priorities as well as eligibility criteria for funding of broadband networks and Digital Service Infrastructures (DSIs).

CEF Work Programmes

Translates the CEF Telecom Guidelines in general objectives and actions planned on a yearly basis.

- a central **machine translation service** run by Directorate-General for Translation (DGT)
- machine translation between 24 official EU languages, Icelandic and Norwegian (Bokmål)
- a machine translation service for public administrations and public online services in various domains/sectors
- available via a **web-user interface** and an **API**
- intended for the following types of users:
 - **online service providers** in European and national public administrations
 - **translators** in EU institutions and in national public administrations
 - **non-translating staff** in EU institutions and in national public administrations

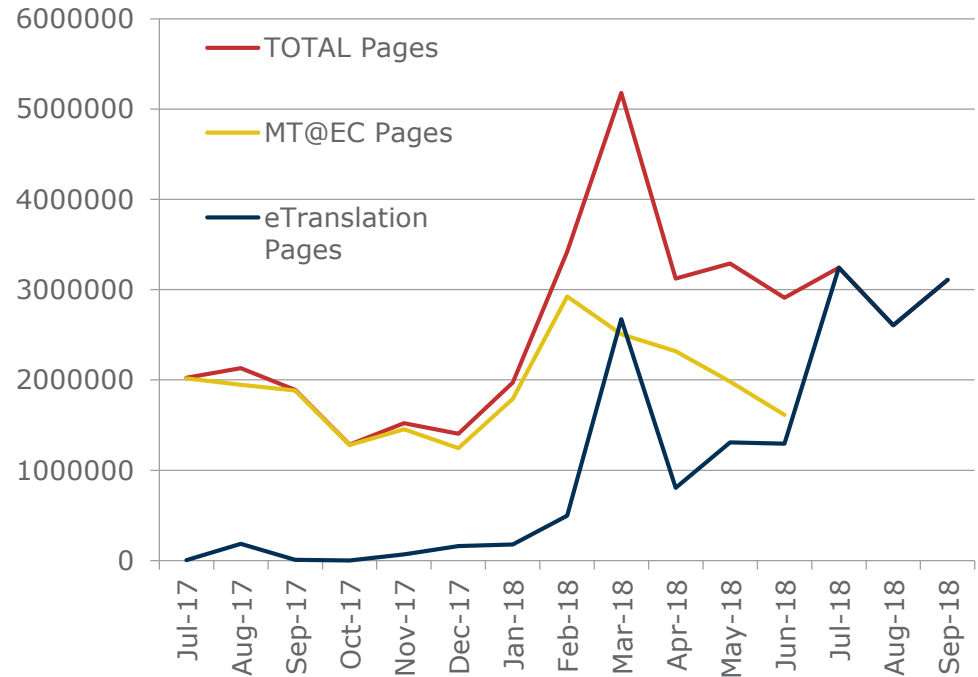

CEF Automated Translation highlights 2018

- **Fully Neural** based Machine Translation (24 into EN and vice-versa)
- **Secured**
- “Public Health” **domain specific engines**
- Translation usage:
 - 19 Mio pages in 2017
 - 29 Mio pages Q1-Q3 2018
- 51 Web service clients connected: including 10 DSIs or INEA grants.
- **Language Resources**
 - 465 available on 10/18
(225 in 4/17; 392 in 4/18; 441 in 9/18)
- LR Workshops 2018 still to go: Budapest, Oslo, Praha, Riga, Nicosia, Zagreb
- **Now available to all CEF member states public services**


